

PRACTICAL EXERCISES

1. Prepare Your CV/Resume and Cover Letter.

Using the guidelines provided in this course, create your own CV or resume and draft a cover letter for a potential job you are interested in applying to. Even if you are not currently seeking employment, select a prospective job for this exercise. To receive your diploma, please email both your cover letter and CV/resume to IMFAHE (QC@imfahe.org).



2. Create an Effective LinkedIn Profile.

If you do not already have a LinkedIn account, register for one, or log in if you have an existing profile. Use the tips provided during this course to build a compelling LinkedIn profile. To qualify for the diploma, share the link to your LinkedIn profile with IMFAHE (QC@imfahe.org).

3. Get ready to succeed in your next interview.

To receive the diploma, complete the following exercise and email your responses to IMFAHE at (<u>QC@imfahe.org</u>):

- 3.1. <u>Dream Job</u>: Think about your ideal job. Write down the position title and the organization where you would love to work (e.g., Immunologist at Pfizer, Software Engineer at Google).
- 3.2. <u>Research the Organization</u>: Study the organization and note what is important to them. Identify five key terms or values that you should incorporate into your responses during an interview to demonstrate alignment with the organization's mission.
- 3.3. <u>Interview Preparation:</u> You've submitted your CV, and now the Organization has requested an interview. Prepare by writing down effective answers to commonly asked interview questions, tailored specifically to the position.



Each student is expected to complete the practical exercises following the guidelines, information and advice presented at the masterclasses. The objective of these exercises is that every student prepares a CV/resume, cover letter, LinkedIn profile, and interview to be ready to get a desired job/position/career goal.
